

Job Description - Green New Deal for Europe (GNDE) Campaign Organizer

The Democracy in Europe Movement (DiEM25) is recruiting a GNDE Campaign Organizer to help grow our movement and boost our people power. The Campaign Organizer is responsible for overseeing DiEM25's GNDE campaigns, developing campaign strategies, and working to onboard, organize and mobilize activists and other organizers to advance the mission of each campaign - and, ultimately, to help further DiEM25's mission of radically reshaping Europe in the years to come. This includes learning from existing organizing techniques and strategies, adapting these for DiEM25's purposes, identifying and onboarding skilled organizers, and reorienting DiEM25 towards a mode of activism that is disruptive, impactful, and threatening to the forces that thwart our collective progress.

Responsibilities

The DiEM25 GNDE Campaign Coordinator will be responsible for:

- Overseeing DiEM25 Green New Deal for Europe campaigns
- Working with the DiEM25 Coordinating Collective to develop an overarching mobilisation strategy to transform DiEM25's political vision into radical demands around which our activists can mobilise
- Helping to identify talented organizers within DiEM25 and outside of it — and organizing training/onboarding sessions that generate concrete and disruptive actions
- Escalating protest action and deploying other strategies to further grow DiEM25's public profile and membership — and to draw attention to issues related to DiEM25's campaigns and policies
- Learning from and building relationships with other impactful movements for change, sharing toolkits, tactics and knowledge to build hegemonic power throughout Europe
- Keeping the Coordinating Collective informed on progress and activities — and working closely with the team to coordinate all activities related to the running of campaigns
- Working to politicise and radicalise other movements and labour unions

Requirements

The successful candidate will have strong analytical skills, a clear understanding of the political opportunities and obstacles within Europe, clearly-articulated socialist politics, and a track record of organizing and mobilizing activists in their local community. Insight into economic policies is an added bonus, but candidates with strong on-the-ground organizing experience will take precedence.

- A key role for our movement to make impact and make it a central point for progressives to find actions which can change people's lives;
- A unique position which will allow you to be in contact with all different bodies of DiEM25, and engage on all of the movement's topics, our local groups across Europe and beyond, our policy pillars and all the remarkable people in our movement;
- And last but not least you will be part of a motivated and creative international team driven by our mission to democratise Europe with a results-oriented attitude.
